Gifted testing will take place in October for students not already identified.

All gifted students will receive an invitation to a gifted Google Classroom for their grade level band (K-2, 3-5, & 6-8). Enrichment tasks will be added weekly in a variety of areas including critical and creative thinking, academic extensions, and social-emotional topics like growth mindset and what it means to be gifted. Mrs. Garis, the gifted instructional coach, is also working with teachers to ensure students are provided with challenge within the classroom and core instruction.

Your child may qualify for free or reduced-price meal benefits. We strongly encourage parents & guardians to apply online through EZMealApp.com to ensure a quick, safe, and contact-less application process. Applications must be submitted annually and may take up to 10 business days to process.

TAXPAYERS CAN LOWER THEIR TAXES AND SUPPORT OUR STUDENTS! You can send all your state taxes to the State of Arizona or make a contribution to a public school and receive a State Income Tax Credit for up to \$200 for tax payers who file a tax return as single or head of household and a maximum of \$400 for married couples filing jointly on your State Income Tax Return.

A.R.S. §43-1089.01 gives you this opportunity to help your local school. A tax credit, which is the dollar-for-dollar reduction of your tax liability, is better than a tax deduction, which only reduces your taxable income before taxes are computed. The tax credit is available to all Arizona taxpayers, regardless of whether they have children in school.
