Spanish

This month 5th-8th grade will continue working on the units they have started at the end of January. 4th grade will work on present progressive and 3rd grade will work on physical descriptions. 2nd grade will learn vocabulary related to cities and towns. They will also learn how to ask and give directions. 1st grade will explore essential vocabulary to talk about parts of their body and Kindergarten will learn words and phrases referring to pets.

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A Note from the District Nurse...



Please make sure that your child's emergency and health form is up-to-date. This provides the school with important information in case an emergency should arise. I encourage parents to speak with the Health Associate if your child has any medical needs or concerns.

TAXPAYERS CAN LOWER THEIR TAXES AND SUPPORT OUR STUDENTS!

You can send all your state taxes to the State of Arizona or make a contribution to a public school and receive a State Income Tax Credit for up to \$200 for tax payers who file a tax return as single or head of household and a maximum of \$400 for married couples filing jointly on your State Income Tax Return.

A.R.S. §43–1089.01 gives you this opportunity to help your local school. A tax credit, which is the dollar-for-dollar reduction of your tax liability, is better than a tax deduction, which only reduces your taxable income before taxes are computed. The tax credit is available to all Arizona taxpayers, regardless of whether they have children in school.
